APC Lay Counseling Center

Arcadia, CA 91006

Arcadia Presbyterian Church Lay Counseling Center provides counseling to individuals eighteen years and older who are not currently abusing alcohol or drugs. Maximum fee is fifteen dollars a session or ability-to-pay basis. Lay counselors are volunteers who have completed one year of formal training by the consulting psychiatrist and program director (a licensed therapist).

Arcadia Child Health Council

As a small nonprofit organization, Arcadia Child Health Council helps children eighteen years and younger without health insurance to meet their medical needs (e.g., glasses, counseling, medical appointments, dental care, hearing aids). The council partners with area physicians and hospitals to render needed services.

Asian Pacific Family Center

Founded in 1986 to serve severely emotionally disturbed children in the San Gabriel Valley, the Asian Pacific Family Center services have expanded to include preventive and educational offerings such as individual, group and family counseling, support groups, mentoring for youth, parent education, and community outreach. Services are currently offered in Mandarin.

Boys and Girls Club of the Foothills

The Boys and Girls Club is a non-profit youth service agency providing supervised activities – crafts and performing arts, social recreation, learning center, and athletic leagues and recreational fitness – for youth age six to eighteen years. The club operates during “critical hours” – after school, summer, and holidays. On average, daily attendance varies from 100 youth (summer) to 150 youth (after school).

Child Health Partnership

This new Monrovia partnership arranges for the delivery of pro bono services with physicians, dentists and social workers for students in Monrovia schools who lack health insurance.

Child/Youth Advocacy Taskforce & Monrovia Reads

Monrovia Reads is a community collaborative with representation from schools, chamber of commerce, city, and others concerned about literacy and education of children and youth.

City of Monrovia – Office of City Manager

City Manager’s Office is the general administrative branch of the city, serving approximately 36,000 residents. The office is involved in working across various departments and agencies, such as police, fire department, community services, and the school district.

El Monte Senior Center

El Monte Senior Center is a multipurpose senior center serving the cities of El Monte, Temple City, Rosemead, South El Monte and adjacent unincorporated areas. Funded by the California Department of Aging, the center also serves as

an adult abuse resource center for individuals eighteen years and older.

Elizabeth House

Elizabeth House is a maternity home for women eighteen years and older in crisis pregnancies. Six families live at Elizabeth House; average stay is six months.

Foothill Unity Center

Foothill Unity provides food, transportation (via bus tokens and cab vouchers), clothing, emergency shelter (via motel vouchers), and focused services for children. The center serves individuals in Monrovia, Arcadia, Duarte, Sierra Madre, and Bradbury.

Fuller Seminary – Psychological Center

The Psychological Center provides general outpatient mental health services through its School of Psychology. Its clients include school-age children and their families, couples, and single adults.

In-Sight

In-Sight offers an intensive outpatient program for adolescent 12 to 18 years of age and their families.

Methodist Hospital – Cancer Resource Center

The Cancer Resource Center provides educational information on diagnosis and treatment of cancer and provides referrals for screenings and other services in the community, such as support groups, home health, and hospice care.

Methodist Hospital – Fifty Plus

Fifty Plus is a free program for individuals fifty years and older. Services include a discounted pharmacy program, education classes and seminars, insurance counseling, and quarterly newsletters. Total enrollment is approximately 4,000 members.

Methodist Hospital – Women’s Clinic

Open since February 2000, Methodist Hospital Women’s Clinic provides prenatal and family planning services to women fifteen years and older. The Clinic’s patients are primarily lower income and Hispanic.

Monrovia Adult School

Monrovia Adult School offers a comprehensive adult school program, including vocational education, academic courses, work preparation, ESL courses, and guidance counseling to meet adult student needs.

Monrovia Health Center

Monrovia Health Center is one of ten public health centers providing clinical services (e.g., tuberculosis, sexually transmitted diseases, immunizations, triage) for the communities of Monrovia, Arcadia, Duarte, Sierra Madre, El Monte, South El Monte, Baldwin Park, Monterey Park, Rosemead, Glendora, Azusa and Altadena. Staff includes public health nurses and community workers.

Monrovia High School – Career Counseling Office

The counseling office at Monrovia high school advises high school students (grade 9 to grade 12) for college and careers, assists with college applications, and has a job shadow program for students.

Monrovia Unified School District – Student Support Services

Monrovia Unified School District provides prevention, intervention, crisis responses, drug, alcohol and tobacco prevention, counseling, and Healthy Start services for 7,000 students and their families.

Our Savior Center

Our Savior Center provides social services such as emergency food, emergency shelter, job training and placement, children and youth tutoring and recreational programs, and parenting classes to the greater El Monte community. A new medical clinic offering preventive health services was recently added.

PALS

PALS is a community-based organization funded entirely by federal, state, county, and private foundation sources. PALS offers medical interpretation, patient advocacy around language access for Limited English Proficient (LEP) individuals, written translation, cultural training, and health education (e.g., topics include breast cancer, cervical cancer, and tuberculosis). The organization serves the counties of Los Angeles and Orange.

Santa Anita Family Services

Since 1951, Santa Anita Family Services has provided educational, mental health and social services for individuals of all ages in the San Gabriel Valley. Santa Anita Family Services also has an intern program for psychology and family therapy students.

Santa Anita Family YMCA

Santa Anita Family YMCA is an independent (charter granted just over one year ago) YMCA serving the communities of Arcadia, Monrovia, Duarte, and Bradbury. Approximately 500 seniors use the facility daily, attending a number of special classes (e.g., Parkinson's, arthritis, Multiple Sclerosis).

Successful Partners Adult Reading Centers (SPARC)

SPARC offers a free literacy program for adults in three area libraries (i.e., Arcadia, Monrovia, and South Pasadena) teaching English-speaking adults to read and write. In addition to 3.5 FTEs, numerous volunteers assist in providing services.
